# **Garbage Disposal**

If you have to run your garbage disposal, run water for 10-15 seconds after you shut it off to completely clear the line and do <u>not</u> throw the following in your garbage disposal (place these items in the trash instead): FOOD SCRAPS, COFFEE GROUNDS, SOLID WASTE, FATS, OIL and GREASE. Remember to let grease cool first and then collect in a container and throw away in the trash.

# Parking in Tu Casa's North Parking Lot – Must display RED Parking Tag
